Even though she had trouble doing other things, she was able to continue to draw. As the years passed, she lost the ability to use her arms and hands but never once lost faith in her heavenly Father or her husband. "My biggest hope and dream is that someday someone will know enough about this horrible disease to figure out where it comes from and how to beat it," she says.
